As a **Mobile Phlebotomist**, your duties will consist of:

- Travel in the Bay Area (mostly Marin County) performing venipuncture and other sample collection methods in support of the clinical trial including fingerstick and saliva collection.
- Candidate will be expected to learn and be proficient in several health information capture devices (pulse wave, weight, BP, audiometry, and others as needed)
- Maintain the integrity of collected samples by applying aseptic techniques and complying with isolation procedures.
- This is a dynamic role that requires self-motivation, flexibility and the desire to learn new techniques.
- Coordinate with VP of Immunology, Director of Data Science and the lead phlebotomist to help ensure that clinical research and related activities are performed in accordance with company policies and procedures.
